New Collaborations:

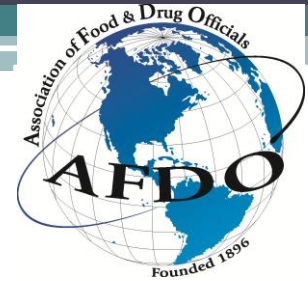
- Submitting a grant proposal to FDA with APHL and AAFCO to collaborate on lab accreditation.

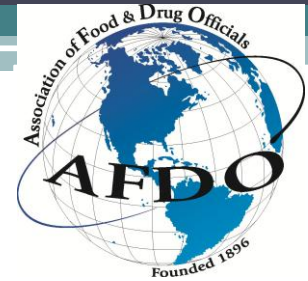
Alliance for Advancing a National Integrated Food Safety System

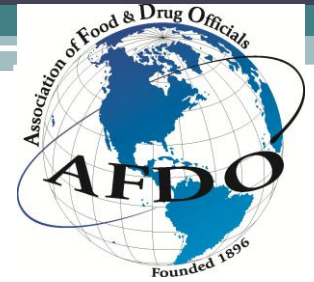
AFDO will do the following:
